We provide information, activities and support for neighborhood residents, represent the neighborhood in city issues, and promote community involvement.

Job Description

We seek two interns to help us design and manage a neighborhood outreach campaign to increase, diversify, and better serve our membership. Responsibilities include:

- Working with our team to develop a targeted multi-media communication strategy to raise awareness of the organization and increase neighborhood engagement
- Helping create and post web content, emails, and flyers
- Designing, monitoring and tabulating responses to neighborhood surveys

Qualifications/Skills

The ideal candidate will be a self-starter with the ability to work independently, and will come with a faculty recommendation. Minimum age: 16. Basic skills include:

- Professional approach
- Demonstrated ability to follow instructions and complete tasks on time
- Basic knowledge of marketing or graphic design
- Excellent writing and communication skills
- Familiarity with or ability to quickly learn new software/communications programs (e.g. WordPress, MailChimp, Canva)

Project Timeline and Benefits

Project will run June 1-July 8, with the bulk of work taking place June 13-30. Each intern will receive a stipend of \$500 for approximately 33 hours of work, to be paid in two installments upon satisfactory completion of projects.
