

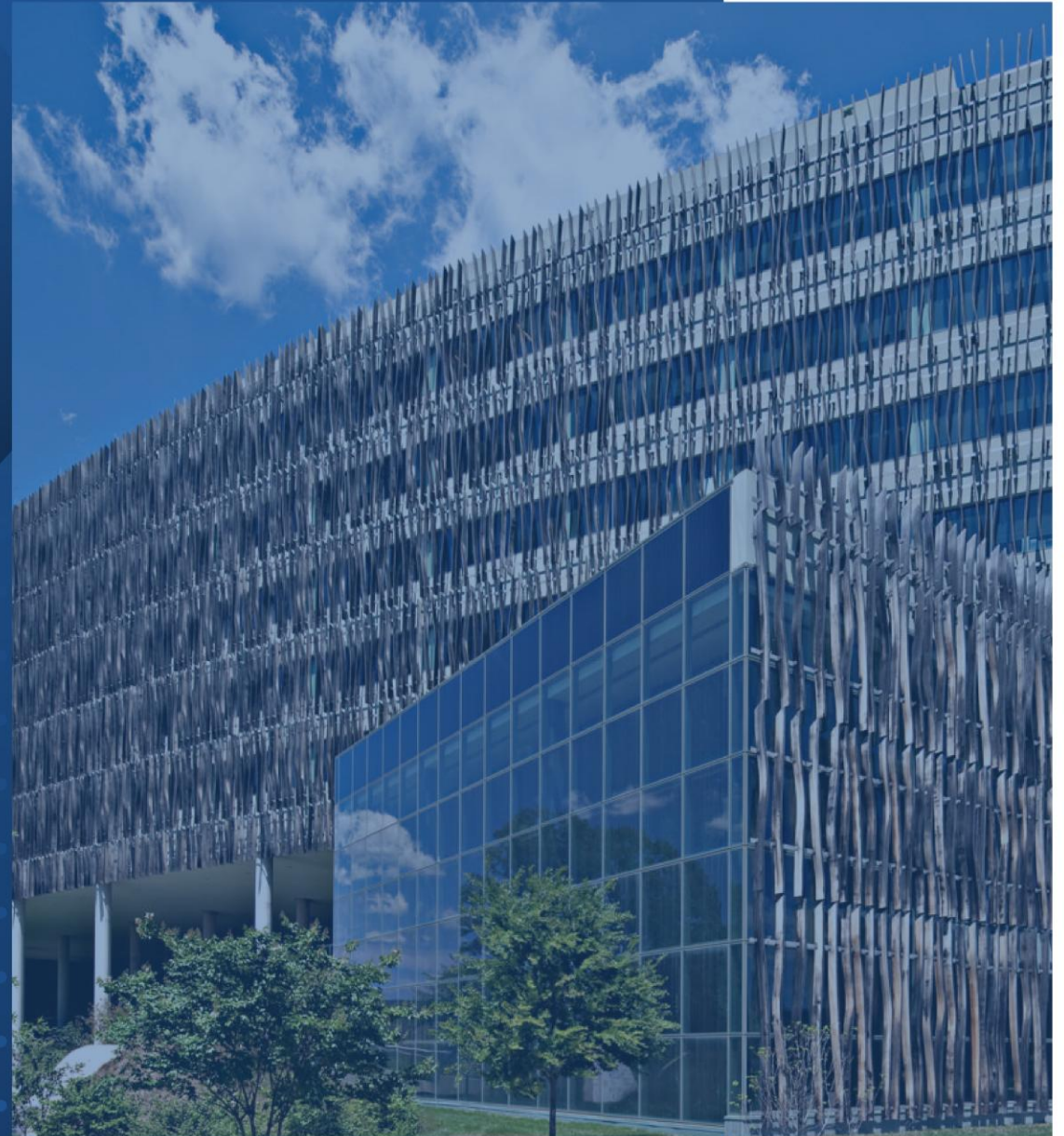

Article I, Section 2 of the Constitution mandates a decennial census:

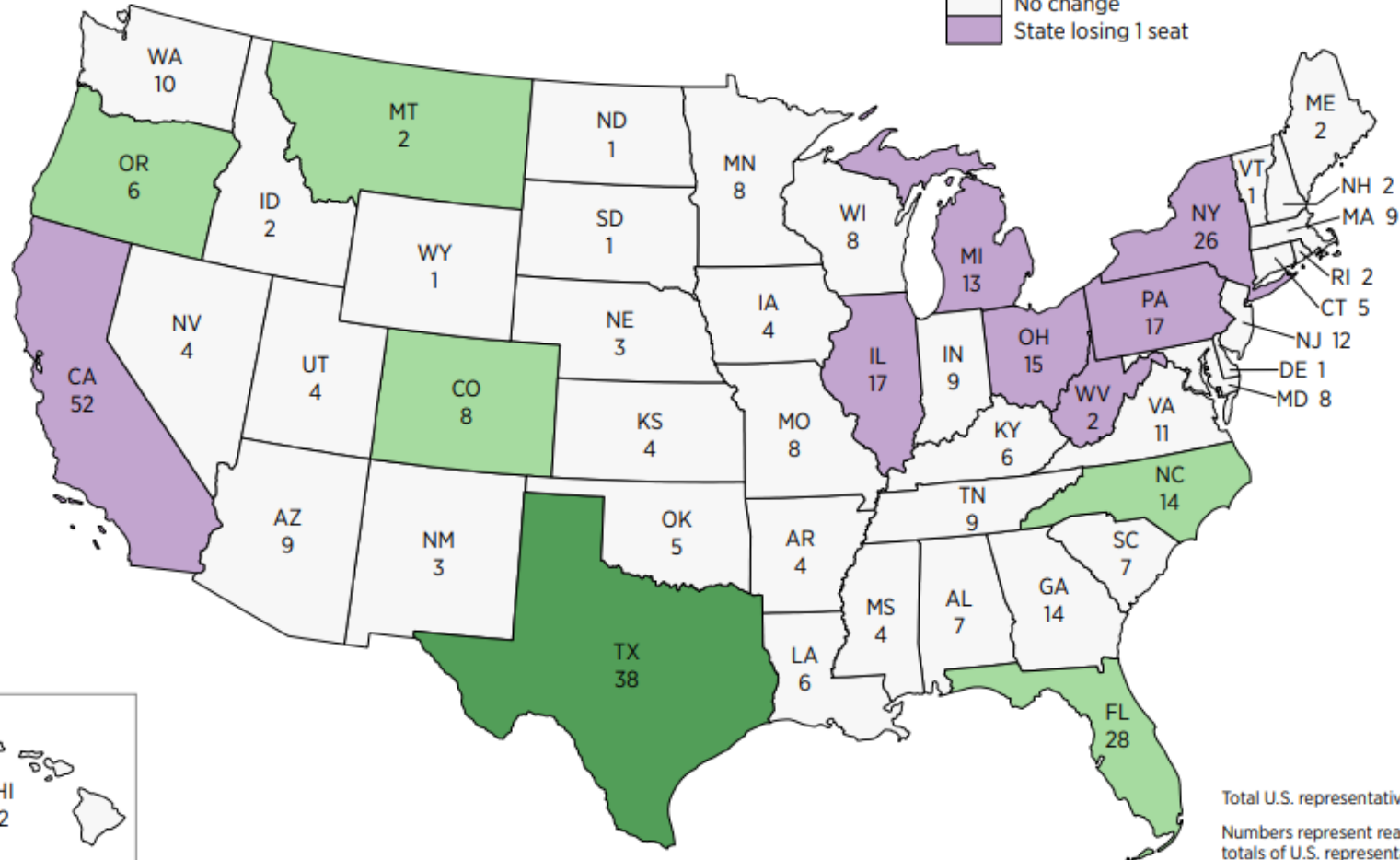
“The actual Enumeration shall be made within three Years after the first Meeting of the Congress of the United States, and within every subsequent Term of ten Years, in such Manner as they shall by Law direct.”

- State losing 1 seat



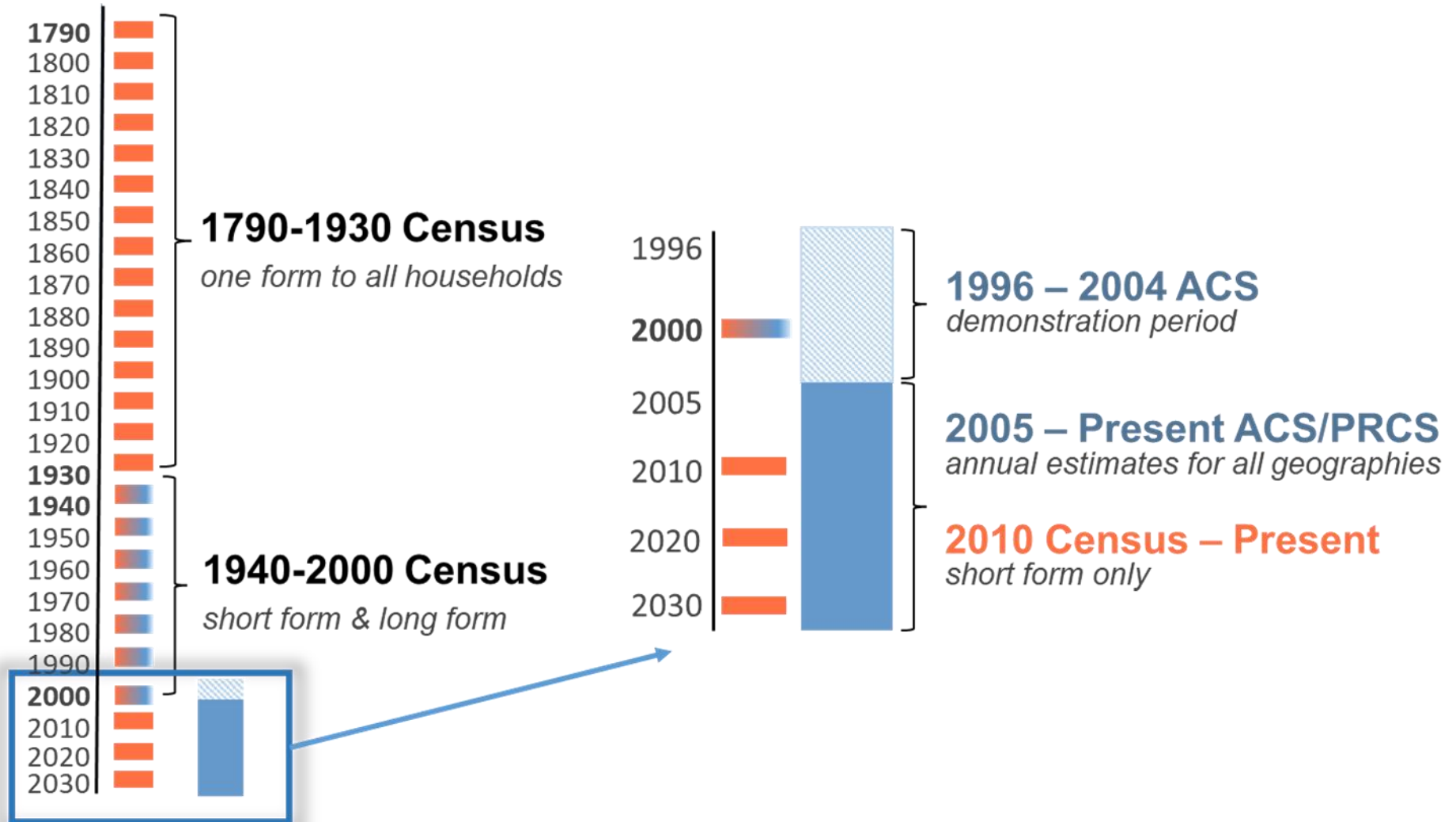

American Community Survey Foundations

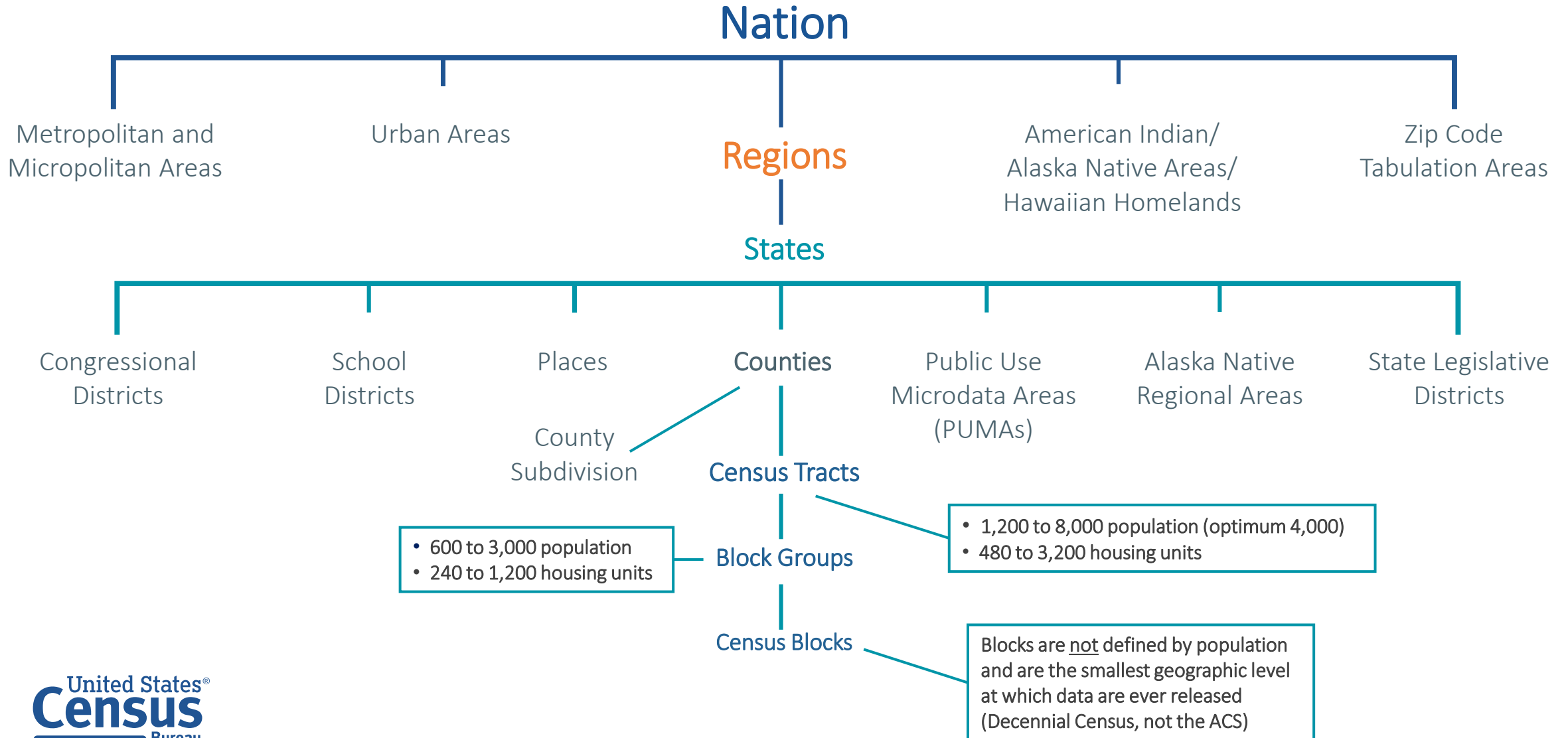
- The American Community Survey (ACS) is the premier source of detailed information about the nation's people and housing.
- Surveys **3.5 million** addresses to produce annual social, economic, housing, and demographic estimates for communities throughout the U.S. and Puerto Rico
- Covers **40+ topics** — Collects detailed information previously collected by the decennial census each decade
- Helps inform how trillions of dollars in federal funds are distributed each year, supports over **300** evidence-based federal government uses
- Data released the year after collection as 1-year and 5-year estimates
- Officially started in 2005 (1-year estimates = 2005; 5-year 2005-2009)

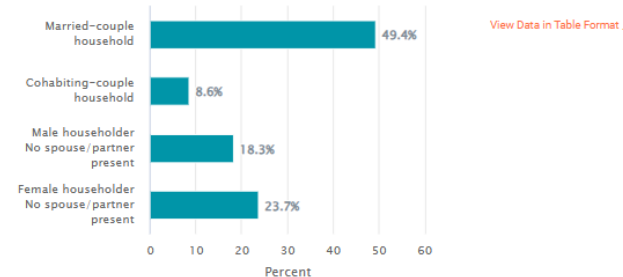
Households and Families

In 2019-2023, there were 3.0 million households in Washington. The average household size was 2.51 people.

Married-couple households made up 49.4 percent of the households in Washington while cohabiting couple households made up 8.6 percent of households. Female householders with no spouse or partner present were 23.7 percent of all households, while 18.3 percent of households had male householders with no spouse or partner present. Some households had one person, as 12.9 percent of households were male householders living alone, and 14.3 percent were female householders living alone, for a total of 27.2 percent of all households.

In Washington, 29.8 percent of all households had one or more people under the age of 18; 29.4 percent of all households had one or more people 65 years and over.

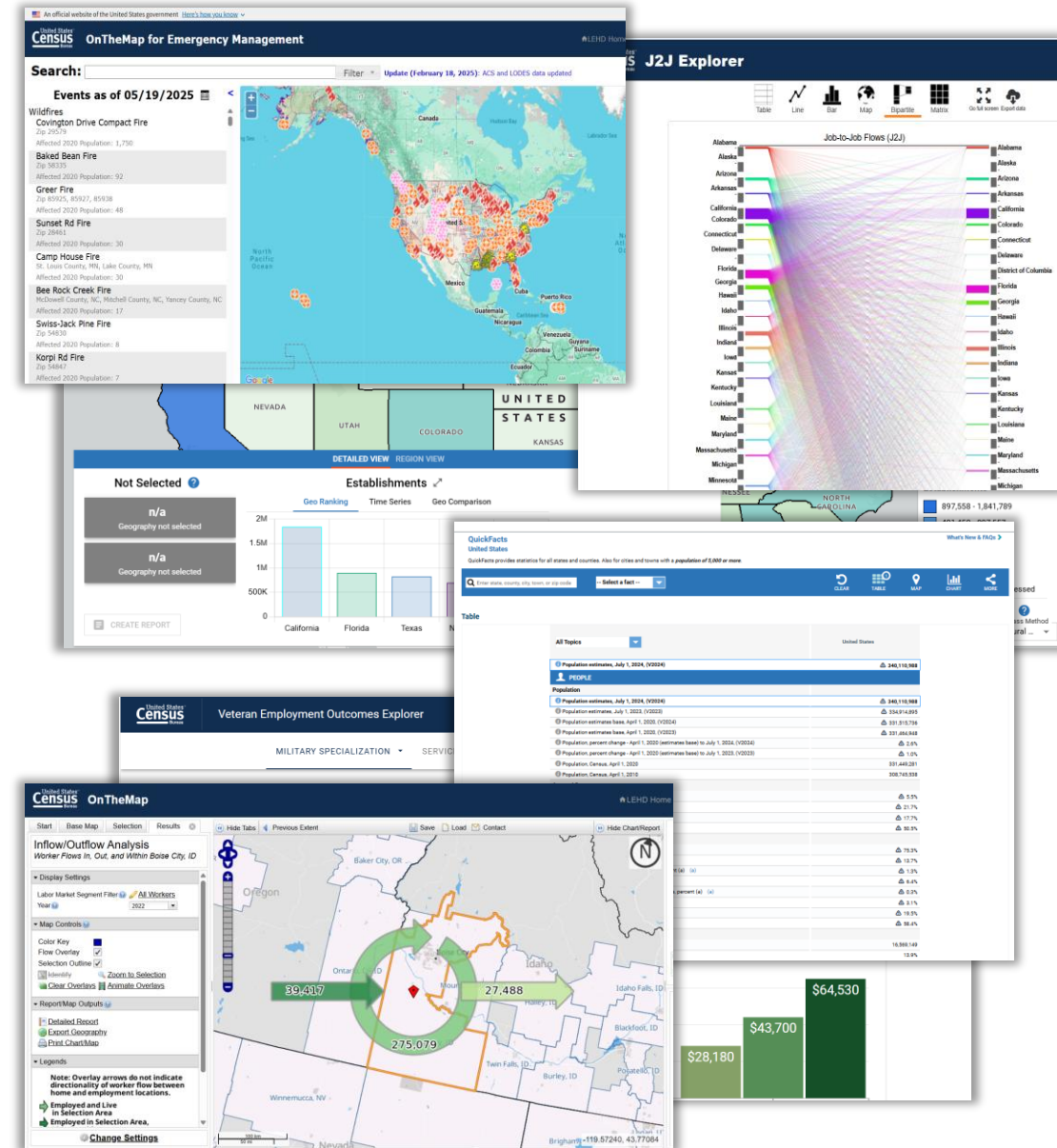

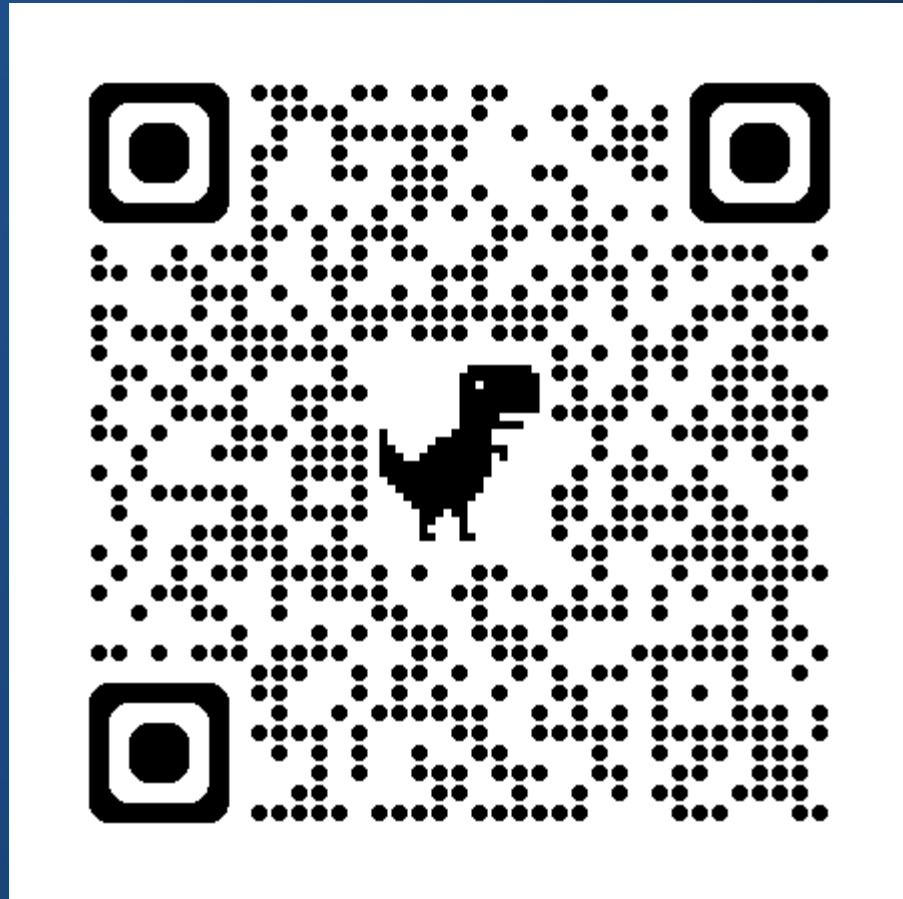
